

ROCK 108's Bagging Benjamin's

These contest rules are specific to the Rock 108 Bagging Benjamin's Promotion (the "Contest") conducted by NRG Media, LLC d/b/a KFMW (the "Company" or the "Station"). Who Can Enter This Contest:

Contestants must be 21 years or older to enter the contest. There will be no possibility of tie-breakers for this contest.

How to enter:

You will fill out an entry form that includes your name, address, email address, telephone number and date of birth. At the end of each remote, we will draw 3 names from all entries at that remote. Each winner will receive a pair of tickets to the concert.

To win tickets or possibly a meet and greet with Breaking Benjamin, join James Patrick at JimmyZ's, 112 2nd street SE Cedar Rapids, Iowa 52401, on Saturday March 16, 2019 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. to play some Bags!

Listeners will enter their name on a signup sheet and that is the order in which each listener will get to throw a cornhole bag into the hole which will be a distance of 27 feet away from the throwing mark. If a contestant makes the cornhole bag completely into the hole, they will win a pair of meet and greets and tickets to Breaking Benjamin at the TaxSlayer Center in Moline on Wednesday, March 20, 2019.

Once all the meet and greets have been won, twenty additional winners will win pairs of tickets in the same manner.

A bag that lands on the board or that is hanging on the board and slightly in the hole, does not constitute a winner. The cornhole bag must fully enter the cornhole board hole. If the cornhole bag is accidentally knocked into the hole by another patron, that does not

constitute a winner. If a patron interferes with a contestant throwing the cornhole bag, the contestant will get a redo. Cornhole bag and cornhole board will be provided by Rock 108.

Prizes:

A total of 6 pairs of meet and greets will be given away. They will also be complimented with 6 pairs of tickets. An extra 18 pairs of tickets will be given away after 6 contestants have won the meet and greets with tickets. Tickets will be available to pick up on location of the promotion. 1 pair of tickets (2 tickets) are valued at \$84. 1 pair of meet and greets (2 people) are valued at \$586 (includes ticket price). Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash value according to ticketmaster.com.
